Monitoring Student Performance Policy

Policy Yipirinya School will monitor and record each student's education performance and use the data collected to improve learning outcomes for our students.

Yipirinya School maintains student education performance record keeping procedures to ensure all prescribed information on student performance is recorded and retained.

The Data We Collect Yipirinya School collects the following data which allows it to monitor outcomes and compare student performance against national standards of education:

- National Assessment Plan – Literacy and Numeracy (NAPLAN);
- Australian Early Learning Development Index (AEDI); and
- moderated school assessment of student achievement.

How we Use the Data The Principal and the School governing body will use the data that we collect to:

- examine trends and analyse how performance has changed over time;
- review the achievements of specific groups of students, and analyse the underlying reasons for their achievements;
- analyse outcomes for individuals and cohorts of students, as they move from one year level to the next;
- look at differences in results between different skill areas within English and Mathematics subjects; and
- compare the School's results with the NT average and other territory-wide information, having regard to schools with similar student backgrounds.
